STUDENTS GENERAL INFORMATION LEADING TO AWARD OF CERTIFICATE IN AGRICULTURE PRODUCTION OR ANIMAL HEALTH AND PRODUCTION COURSES

1 Introduction:

Kaole Wazazi College of Agriculture is an Institute recognized and registered by the National Council for Technical Education (NACTE) with registration number **REG/STA/021**

2. Location

The college is located 64 Kilometres North of Dar es Salaam city and about 3 km South of Bagamoyo town along the road leading to Kaole Ruins.

3. Students enrolment

Applications for Academic year **2019/2020** will start on **May 2019 up to Mid Sept. 2019** and Announcement of selected students will be on **September 2019** while Reporting at the College will be **Early October 2019**.

4. Courses Offered and duration

The college is offering **two year** certificate courses in :-

A. Certificate course in **AGRICULTURE PRODUCTION**

(i) **Entry qualifications:**

Candidates for this course should have attained certificate of secondary school education with at least four passes out of which two passes must be of science subject (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Geography and agriculture). Also, candidates who have attained entry level three in Agriculture and Livestock training from recognized Vocational Training Centre (VETA).

(ii) **Tuition fees and other financial requirements.**

Total Tuition fees is Tsh. **1,700,000/=** per academic year with addition of **fifty thousand (50,000)** at his/her fourth semester as graduation fees to be met by students as shown in the table below. Fees must be paid in full or in two installments, i.e. full semester fees on the day of reporting.

5. College Clothing

To maintain college integrity and credibility, all students must keep decency for character and attitude to work assessment. Students are required at all times during normal hours of study and at practical hours to be in accepted decent clothes. Wearing of Mini and micro skirts or clothes which do not cover fully the groins and the abdomen or transparent clothes is prohibited. 6. Identity card and registration fee

7. Practical wear and laboratory attire.

8. Medical examination

All students will therefore be required to submit a satisfactory Medical Examination report from a recognized Health Facility duly filled, signed and stamped by a qualified Licensed or registered Medical Practitioner. **Students are advised to bring their own Health Insurance cards**

9. Discipline

Every student is expected to be exemplary in the society, that is good behaviour and maintain self-respect in accordance with the rules and regulations of the institute. It is the responsibility of the student to maintain self-discipline and respect of others. You will be provided with a copy of institute rules and regulations, which each student should abide to.

10. Seriousness in studies

In order to graduate, a candidate will need to pass all examinations (Continuous assessment and end of semester Examinations). Students are advised to familiarize themselves with the guidelines for assessment and examinations.

11. Education for self – reliance

In accordance with the institute's objectives, students are required to participate in various production activities, both crop and livestock production.

12. Health Care

A sense of good health is mandatory to all students. General cleanliness and personal hygiene is hereby emphasized.

During registration each student must produce original documents like Certificate, statement of results, academic transcripts and Birth certificate. Duplicates and photocopied documents are strictly prohibited.

- Hand Cloves 1 box (Certificate in Animal Health and Prodn)
- Exercise books, pens, pencils, ruler and Scientific calculator (Both certificates in Crop Podn. and Animal Health & Prodn))
- Water bucket (Both certificates in Crop Podn. and Animal Health & Prodn)
- A pair of Gum boots (Both certificates in Crop Podn. and Animal Health & Prodn)
- Overall (Blue) (Both certificates in Crop Podn. and Animal Health & Prodn)
- Over Coat (white) (Both certificates in Crop Podn. and Animal Health & Prodn)
- Two (2) reams of photocopy papers (Nopatop) per academic Semester (Both certificates in Crop Podn. and Animal Health & Prodn)

15. Nacte fees

All students admitted to Institutes registered by National Council for Technical Education, (NACTE) should pay 15,000/- each academic year as quality Assurance fee.
