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STUDENTS INFORMATIONS LEADING TO AWARD OF DIPLOMA IN AGRICULTURE PRODUCTION OR ANIMAL HEALTH AND PRODUCTION COURSES

1. Introduction:

Kaole Wazazi College of Agriculture is an Institute recognized and registered by the National Council for Technical Education (NACTE) with registration number **REG/STA/021**

2. Location

The college is located 64 Kilometres North of Dar es Salaam city and about 3 km South of Bagamoyo town along the road leading to Kaole Ruins.

3. Students enrolment

Applications for Academic year **2019/2020** will start on **May 2019 up to Mid Sept. 2019** and Announcement of selected students will be on **September 2019** while Reporting at the College will be **Early October 2019**.

4. Courses Offered and duration

The college is offering **one year** course Diploma in AGRICULTURE PRODUCTION (**DAP**) and **one year** course Diploma in Animal Health and Production(**DAHP**)as shown below:-

A. DIPLOMA IN AGRICULTURE PRODUCTION (DAP)), DIPLOMA IN CROP PRODUCTION (DCP)

(i) Entry qualifications:

Candidates should have passed a certificate course in General Agriculture (CGA NTA Level 5) from any Agriculture Training Institute recognized and registered by NACTE. A candidate should have passed at least four passes out of which two passes must be of science subjects (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology Geography and Agriculture).

Form Six leavers should have one Principa passl and one subsidiary pass in Science subjects. It is a two year Diploma course for Form six leavers.

(ii) Tuition fees and other financial requirements.

Total Tuition fees is Tsh. **2,000,000/=** per academic year with addition of **fifty thousand (50,000)** at his/her second semester as graduation fees to be met by students as shown in the table below. Fees must be paid in full or in two installments

B. DIPLOMA COURSE IN ANIMAL HEALTH AND PRODUCTION (DAHP)

(i) Entry qualifications:

Candidates should have passed a certificate course in Animal Health and Production (AHPC NTA Level 5) from any Livestock Training Institute recognized and registered by NACTE. A candidate should have passed at least four passes out of which two passes must be of science subjects (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology Geography and Agriculture). Form Six leavers should have one Principal pass and one subsidiary pass in Science subjects. It is a three year Diploma course for Form six leavers.

(ii) Tuition fees and other financial requirements.

Total Tuition fees is Tshs. **2,200,000/=** per academic year with addition of **fifty thousand (50,000)** at his/her second semester as graduation fees to be met by students to be met by students. Fees must be paid in full or in two installments, as shown in the table below

5. College Clothing

To maintain college integrity and credibility, all students must keep decency for character and attitude to work assessment. Students are required at all times during normal hours of study and at practical hours to be in accepted decent clothes. 6. Identity card and registration fee

7. Practical wear and laboratory attire.

The nature of the course demands special practical working wear. Each student should make sure to bring with him/her the following

- Overall (blue)

8. Medical examination

All students will therefore be required to submit a satisfactory Medical Examination report from a recognized Health Facility duly filled, signed and stamped by a qualified Licensed or registered Medical Practitioner. **Students are advised to bring their own Health Insurance cards**

9. Discipline

Every student is expected to be exemplary in the society, that is good behaviour and maintain self-respect in accordance with the rules and regulations of the institute. It is the responsibility of the student to maintain self-discipline and respect of others. You will be provided with a copy of institute rules and regulations, which each student should abide to.

10. Seriousness in studies

In order to graduate, a candidate will need to pass all examinations (Continuous assessment and end of semester Examinations). Students are advised to familiarize themselves with the guidelines for assessment and examinations.

11. Education for self – reliance

In accordance with the institute's objectives, students are required to participate in various production activities, both crop and livestock production.
